Murray Fingeret, O.D.

Dr. Murray Fingeret, a graduate of the New England College of Optometry, completed a residency at the Joseph C. Wilson Health Center in Rochester, New York. He is Chief of the Optometry Section, Brooklyn/St. Albans Campus, Department of Veterans Administration New York Harbor Health Care System, a Clinical Professor at the State University of New York, College of Optometry and a fellow of the American Academy of Optometry. Dr. Fingeret sits on the Board of Directors of the Glaucoma Foundation. He is a founding member and past-president of the Optometric Glaucoma Society and is the recipient of the 2013 Vincent Ellerbrock Clinician Educator Award from the American Academy of Optometry, 2008 Distinguished Service Award Optometric Glaucoma Society, 2005 Carel C. Koch Memorial Medal from the American Academy of Optometry, 1996 Otsuka Glaucoma Educators Award from the American Academy of Optometry and 1999 AMSUS Federal Service Optometrist of the Year award. Dr. Fingeret is on the editorial boards for the Journal of Glaucoma, International Glaucoma Review, Glaucoma Today, Primary Care Optometry News, Optometry Times and Review of Optometry and has authored numerous articles and co-authored the texts "Atlas of Primary Eyecare Procedures" and "Primary Care of the Glaucomas".

Katherine Bickle, O.D.

Dr. Bickle is a clinical instructor and PhD student at The Ohio State University College of Optometry. She is also in private practice at ProCare Vision Centers in Granville, OH. She graduated with a Master of Science in Vision Science and Doctor of Optometry degrees from The Ohio State University. While attending optometry school, she was awarded the National Eye Institute T35 research grant. Her master's degree research focused on children's visual performance objectively and subjectively with soft multifocal contact lenses. Additionally, she completed a cornea and contact lens fellowship at the University of Houston College of Optometry. Dr. Bickle continues to be involved with clinical studies.
