## LECTURERS

### Arthur Epstein, O.D.

Dr. Epstein is a native New Yorker who received an O.D. degree from the State University of New York, State College of Optometry where he also served as the college's first resident in ocular disease. He is a founding partner of North Shore Contact Lens & Vision Consultants, P.C., a referral based contact lens and primary eye care practice on Long Island. After relocating to Phoenix, AZ. Dr. Epstein co-founded Phoenix Eye Care, with his wife, Dr. Shannon Steinhäuser. Dr. Epstein heads the practice's Dry Eye - Ocular Surface Disease Center and serves as its Director of Clinical Research. With internationally recognized expertise in complex contact lens management and an acknowledged expert on the medical complications of contact lenses, dry eye, and anterior segment disease Dr. Epstein also serves as an Adjunct Clinical Associate Professor at Midwestern University, Arizona College of Optometry Eye Institute. Dr. Epstein is a prolific author who has published hundreds of articles, scientific papers and book chapters.

### Katherine Bickle, O.D.

Dr. Bickle is a post-doctoral clinical and research fellow for The Ocular Surface Institute (TOSI) at the University of Houston, College of Optometry. She graduated with a Master of Science in Vision Science and Doctor of Optometry degrees from The Ohio State University. While attending optometry school, she was awarded the National Eye Institute T35 research grant. Her master's degree research focused on children's visual performance objectively and subjectively with soft bifocal contact lenses. Dr. Bickle continues to be involved in several clinical studies.

### Richard A. Erdey, M.D.

Dr. Erdey is a cataract, corneal and refractive specialist and is board certified. His training included an ophthalmology residency at North Shore Cornell Medical Center in New York where he was chief resident. He then did a Cornea Fellowship at The Ohio State University and subsequently co-directed the Cornea Research Laboratory at The University of Rochester. He reestablished his practice in Columbus in 1992, and is currently the Medical Director at both the Erdey Searcy Eye Group and East Columbus Surgery Center. Dr. Erdey has published numerous articles and lectures extensively.

### Gregory D. Searcy, M.D.

Dr. Searcy is a board certified ophthalmologist practicing at the Erdey Searcy Eye Group in Columbus. He is also a Clinical Assistant Professor at The Ohio State University. Dr. Searcy graduated with a doctor of medicine degree from The Ohio State University. He was a resident and chief resident at the St. Francis Medical Center Department of Ophthalmology in Pittsburgh. Dr. Searcy has given numerous presentations and has been involved in numerous clinical studies.

### Daryl Kaswinkel, M.D

Dr. Kaswinkel is a board certified ophthalmologist practicing at the Erdey Searcy Eye Group (Columbus and Newark-Granville locations). He received his doctor of medicine degree from the University of Tennessee. He is fellowship-trained in cornea, external disease, uveitis, refractive and glaucoma surgery from the University of Louisville. He has extensive experience in a variety of Ophthalmology practices.
